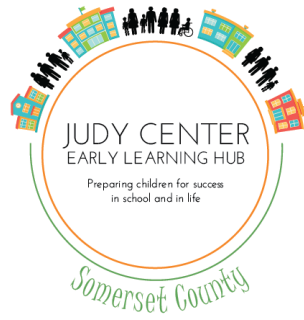

The Judy Center is a grant sponsored program through the Maryland State Dept. of Education. Judith P. Hoyer Early Child Care and Family Education Centers or "Judy Centers," provide access to early childhood education and family support programs located at or near Title I schools. Typically, education opportunities and support services are available 7-12 hours a day, year round. Judy Centers serve young children and their families in an effort to increase the number of children entering school ready to learn. They are unique because they promote school readiness through collaboration with community-based agencies, organizations and businesses. Most services or assistance a family may need can be provided directly or arranged by the Judy Center onsite or nearby, including health care, adult education, identification of special needs and early intervention, child care, parenting classes, and family literacy.

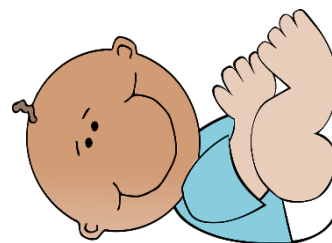

Affiliated Santé MCT members intervene with callers referred from the ESOC who are experiencing a behavioral health emergency, assist law enforcement and emergency responders by providing behavioral health crisis consultation and intervention to stabilize the individual in the least restrictive environment through a range of services including assessment, crisis intervention, supportive counseling, information and referrals to appropriate community based behavioral health services for ongoing treatment and follow-up.

Mobile Treatment Teams (MTT)

Lower Shore Clinic team treatment approach designed to assist the individual to: achieve recovery, fully participate in community life, obtain stable permanent housing, and reduce the individual's unnecessary admissions to emergency rooms and inpatient psychiatric services. Two teams are available on the Eastern Shore and both are working toward ACT fidelity. To be eligible you must be 18 years of age, diagnosed with a serious mental illness, be homeless, or at risk of becoming homeless, and must have difficulty in three of the four areas- activities of daily living, social situations, concentration and learning abilities, and increased symptoms of mental illness.
